Physical strength and energy.

"He tackled the project with real vigor."

Enthusiasm

Eager interest and excitement.

"She joined the club with great enthusiasm."

Creativity

The ability to produce original ideas.

"Youth often bring creativity to old problems."

Open-mindedness

Willingness to consider new ideas.

"Open-mindedness helps you learn from others."

Optimism

Hopefulness about the future.

"His optimism kept the whole team motivated."

Self-confidence

Belief in one's own abilities.

"Public speaking practice builds self-confidence."

Determination

Firmness of purpose.

"Her determination helped her finish the race."

Adventurous

Willing to take risks and try new things.
