CARD 01

n.

Humour

The quality of being funny.

"His humour lightened the mood in class."

CARD 02

adj.

Witty

Cleverly amusing.

"She gave a witty reply that made everyone laugh."

CARD 03

n.

Sarcasm

Words used to mean the opposite, often mockingly.

"His sarcasm wasn't appreciated by the teacher."

CARD 04

n.

Irony

A contrast between expectation and reality.

"It was pure irony that the fire station burned down."

CARD 05

n.

Satire

Humour used to criticize society.

"The show uses satire to comment on politics."

CARD 06

n.

Parody

A humorous imitation of something.

"The film is a parody of classic action movies."

CARD 07

n.

Pun

A joke based on wordplay.

"He loves making puns about food."

CARD 08

n.

Comedian

A person who makes people laugh professionally.

"The comedian had the whole audience laughing."

CARD 09

adj.

Hilarious

Extremely funny.

"The video was absolutely hilarious."

n.

Laughter

The act of laughing.

"Laughter is said to be the best medicine."
