Empowerment

Giving someone power and confidence.

Emancipation

Freeing someone socially or politically.

"The reform was a step toward women's emancipation."

Feminism

The movement for equal rights for women.

"Feminism has changed attitudes across generations."

Discrimination

Unfair treatment based on gender or other traits.

"The report highlighted workplace discrimination."

Patriarchy

A system where men hold most of the power.

"The novel critiques patriarchy in traditional society."

Glass ceiling

An invisible barrier limiting advancement.

"She broke through the glass ceiling in her company."

Stereotype

An oversimplified, fixed idea about a group.

"The film challenges common gender stereotypes."

Equal rights and opportunities for all genders.

"Gender equality remains a global goal."
