Citizenship

The status of being a member of a country.

"Citizenship comes with both rights and duties."

n.

Rights

Things a person is legally entitled to.

"The right to education is protected by law."

CARD 03

n.

Obligations

Duties a person must fulfil.

"Paying taxes is one of our civic obligations."

CARD 04

adj.

Altruistic

Caring about the good of others.

"The volunteer's altruistic work inspired the whole town."

CARD 05

n.

Volunteer

Someone who helps without expecting payment.

"She works as a volunteer at the local shelter."

CARD 06

n.

NGO

A non-governmental organisation.

"The NGO provides support to disadvantaged families."

CARD 07

n.

Charity

An organisation that helps people in need.

"The charity collects donations every winter."

CARD 08

n.

Civic duty

A responsibility as a member of society.

"Voting is considered a civic duty."

Community service

Unpaid work helping the local community.

"Students take part in community service projects."

v.

Lobby

To try to influence political decisions.

"Activists lobby the government for stronger laws."
